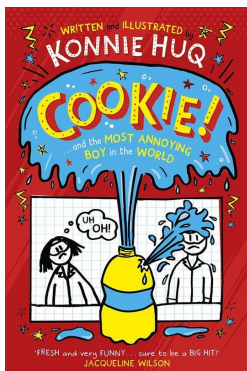
Well done
