

Sport Premium 2016/17

Bearwood Sport Premium allocation for 2016/17 is £9 792

The PE and sport premium is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils.

At Bearwood, for two years, we have used our funding to employ a sports coach at lunchtime and after school and also to work alongside teachers to improve the quality of p.e delivered in lessons. We have also used the funding to provide training for lunchtime supervisors.

This strategy has been very successful in increasing participation in sport and in supporting teachers and dinner supervisors to develop their practice.

From April 2016 until the end of the summer term, we will continue to use this strategy and then from September 2016, having taken on board advice and training from the coach, we will use the remaining allocation to fund school staff to complete the activities below, previously done by the coach to assess if the school can sustain the work of the coach alone.
