PSHE Curriculum

In September 2020, we introduced our new PSHE curriculum across the school, in order to fulfil the requirements of the Statutory Relationships and Health Education Curriculum.

Each half term the whole school learns about the same topic.

These are :

Being Me in My World
Celebrating Difference
Dreams and Goals
Healthy Me
Relationships
Changing Me

For most of the topics we use the Jigsaw learning resources. You may have seen some of these when children were learning at home this year. They are really excellent and promote lots of good discussion in class.

This half term we are looking at “Changing Me” preparing positively for changes as the children move year groups or even school.

For this half term topic we are using **some** Jigsaw resources, but senior staff have adapted and edited these materials so that they are appropriate for all of our children and in line with what Governors agreed.

We introduce puberty to girls in Year 4 and we teach puberty to girls and boys in Year 5 and 6. (These are one or two lessons)

As agreed by Governors and outlined in our policy, we do not teach Sex Education at Bearwood.
